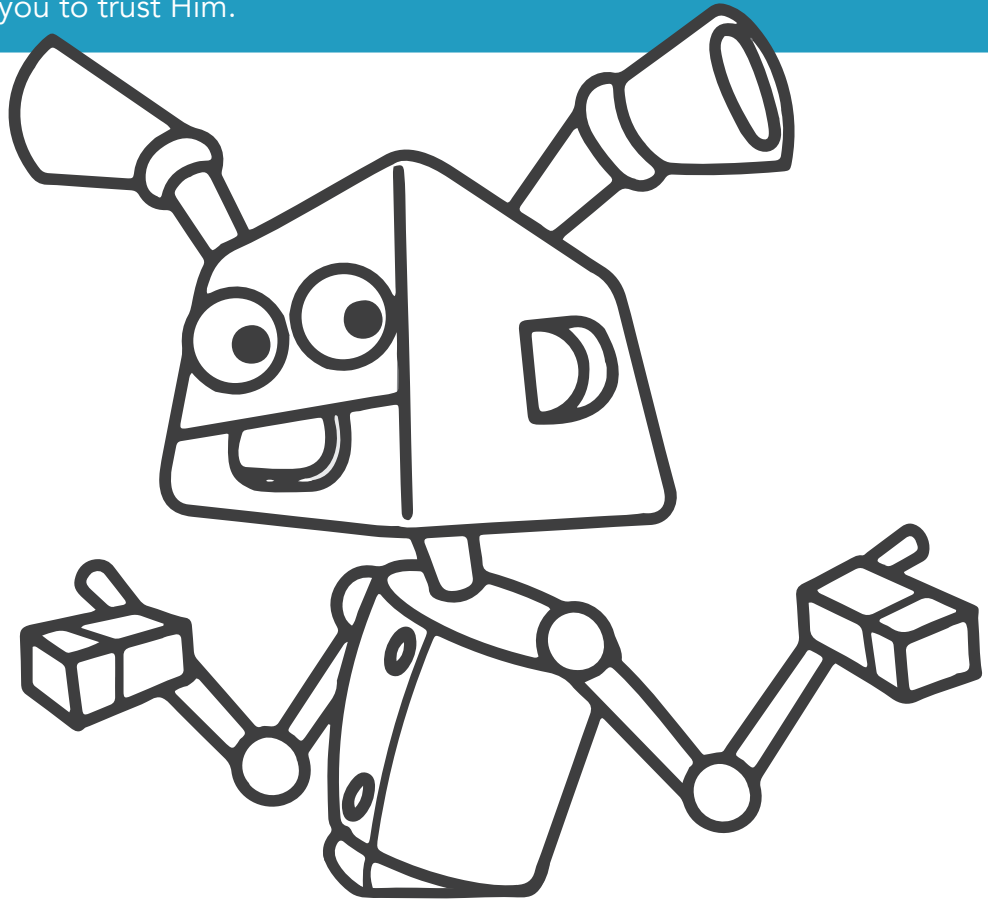


DAY 2

Trust Me

Allow yourself to be blindfolded by an adult you trust. Ask them to give you things like something to drink or a snack to eat. Ask them to lead you somewhere you would like to go, and then have them remove the blindfold. Think about how easy it was to trust the adult to take care of you, even though you could not see what was happening around you. Even more than you trust this grown-up, you can trust God.

Trust Doodle

Write the word "trust" in the middle of a sheet of paper. Using the rest of the page, doodle things that remind you that you can trust God. Think about the things in nature, like the sunrise in the morning or the changing of the seasons. Think also about the people God has placed in your life that help you, whether it is once or every day.

Sing a Prayer

Make up a tune and turn your prayer into a song: "God, help me to trust You in the big things and the small things. Help me to remember that nothing is greater than You and that You love me. Thank You for loving me and thank You for always being someone I can trust. Amen."
